**A PROCLAMATION**

**NOW THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG,** Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on **Thursday the 30th day of December 2021.**

**AND THE PRESIDENT** of the Senate, the **SPEAKER** of the House of Representatives, the Members of the Senate and the Members of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.
