Proclamation dated the 30th day of July, 1999, appointing the 3rd day of August, 1999 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

A PROCLAMATION

Sir James B. Carlisle,

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do hereby appoint Tuesday 3rd day of August, 1999, to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua, this 30th day of July, 1999, in the forty-eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
