A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams,

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 (a) of the Public Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda, and any day or part of a day so appointed shall be kept as a close holiday in all banks, shops, stores and public offices aforesaid in Antigua and Barbuda, and shall, as regards bills of exchange and promissory notes be deemed to be a public holiday for all purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet appoint Tuesday the 4th day of July, 2023 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating CARICOM's 50th Anniversary.
