## BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

### A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams, Governor General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS**, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Fourth Session of Parliament shall be held at 9:00 a. m on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2021 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor General's Office, Antigua this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2020 and in the sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
