PROCLAMATION dated the 31st day of March, 2005 appointing the 9th day of May, 2005 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation—

- (a) appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda;
- (b) declaring that in any year it is inexpedient that a day by this Act appointed a public holiday shall not in such year be a public holiday, and appointing such other day as to him may seem fit to be a public holiday instead of such day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet—

- (a) declare that for the year 2005, Monday the 2nd day of May, 2005 shall not be a public holiday in Antigua and Barbuda in commemoration of Labour Day; and
- (b) instead do appoint Monday the 9th day of May, 2005, to be the public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating Labour Day.
