PROCLAMATION dated the 3rd day of March, 1995 calling out a number of the members of the Volunteer Element of the Antigua and Barbuda Defence Force.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 118 of the Defence Act, 1981 (No. 8 of 1981) that the Governor-General may, at any time when the occasion appears to require, call out the volunteer element, or as many members thereof as is thought necessary, on temporary service:

AND WHEREAS a number of regular members of the Force is required to take part in the Peacekeeping operations in Haiti under the authority of the United Nations Mission in Haiti (UMIH) commencing on 5th March, 1995, and also to assist the Civil Authorities to maintain order in light of the present crime situation in Antigua:

NOW THEREFORE, I James Carlisle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, acting in accordance with the advice of Cabinet, do hereby command the Antigua and Barbuda Defence Force to call out as many members of the Volunteer Element as is thought necessary on temporary service.

Given at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, this 3rd day of March, 1995, and in the forty-fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
