**PROCLAMATION** dated the 4th day of December, 2012, appointing the Place and Time for the Fifth Session of Parliament.

**BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

**WHEREAS** it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAME LOUISE AGNETHA LAKE-TACK,** Governor-General, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Fifth Session of Parliament shall be held at 9:00 a.m. on the 12th of December, 2012 as the time at which that session shall begin.

**GIVEN** at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 4th day of December, 2012, and in the sixty-first year of Her Majesty's Reign.
