PROCLAMATION dated the 4th day of January, 2017, Appointing the Place and Time for the Fourth Session of Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Second Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 9th day of January, 2017 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, Antigua, this 4th day of January, 2017, and in the sixty-sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
