**A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS** it is provided by section 60(1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor-General,** acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Thursday the 5th January, 2017.

**AND THE PRESIDENT** of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

**GIVEN** at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 4th day of January, 2017, and in the sixty-sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
