Proclamation dated the 5th day of December, 2007 appointing the 10th of December, 2007 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

A PROCLAMATION

Dame Louise Lake-Tack, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation declaring that it is inexpedient in any year that a day by this Act appointed a public holiday shall not in such year be a public holiday, and appoint such other day as to her may seem fit to be a public holiday instead of such day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I LOUISE LAKE-TACK, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet—

- (a) declare that for the year 2007, Sunday the 9th of December, 2007 shall not be a public holiday in Antigua and Barbuda in commemoration of National Heroes Day; and
- (b) instead do appoint Monday the 10th of December, 2007 to be the public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating National Heroes Day.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office St. John's, Antigua, This 5th day of December, 2007 and in the fifty-sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
