**Proclamation dated the 7th day of September, 1995 appointing the place and time for the emergency meeting of Parliament.**

**A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 5th day of September 1995, the Cabinet declared a State of Emergency under the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 307;

AND WHEREAS by Section 2 (3) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act Cap. 307 a proclamation so made shall be communicated to the Legislature and the Legislature shall accordingly meet and sit upon the day appointed by proclamation, and shall continue to sit and act in like manner as if it had stood adjourned or prorogued to the same day;

NOW THEREFORE, I James Beethoven Carlisle, Knight Grand Cross of the most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building as the place at which Parliament shall be held and 10:00 a.m. on Monday the 11th day of September 1995 as the time at which that meeting shall begin.

Given at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 7th day of September, 1995 and in the forty-fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
