Proclamation dated the 8th day of May, 2008 declaring a Close Season for Cotton

BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

A PROCLAMATION

Dame Louise Lake-Tack, Governor-General.

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Cotton Protection Act (Cap. 111) it is provided that the Governor-General on the advice of the Cabinet may by proclamation published in the *Gazette* and by public notice, declare any period of each year to be a close season within the meaning of the said Act, either for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda or for such areas thereof as may be specified in such proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE LAKE-TACK, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, on the advice of the Cabinet, do by this my PROCLAMATION declare that the period 1st May to 1st August 2008 both days inclusive, be declared the Cotton Close Season within the meaning of the said Act for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda.

AND all her Majesty's loving subjects in Antigua and Barbuda and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, Antigua this 8th day of May, 2008 and in the fifty-seventh year of her Majesty's Reign.
