Proclamation dated the 8th day of November, 2004, Proroguing Parliament.

**BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60(1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, DAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Monday the 8th of November, 2004. AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

St. John's, Antigua this 8th day of November,
2004 and in the fifty-third year of Her Majesty's
Reign.
