**THE PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION)  
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 15) ORDER** made in exercise of the powers contained in section 4 of the Prevention of Terrorism Act 2005, No. 12 of 2005 which authorises the Minister of Foreign Affairs to make such provision as may appear to him to be necessary or expedient to enable the measures of the United Security Council 1267 Sanctions Committee to be effectively applied in Antigua and Barbuda.

**1. Short title**

This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Security Council Resolution) (Amendment) (No. 15) Order, 2019.

**2. Commencement**

The Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 28th day of August, 2019.

**3. Amendment of Schedule**

(1) The Schedule is being revised by amending the individuals designated as—

also subject to the sanctions measures set out in Security Council resolution 1844

(2008) concerning Somalia and Eritrea

Abdullah Hersi Al-Turki (QDi.172) and Hassan Dahir Aweys (QDi.042). AIAI has
