THE PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 17) ORDER, made in exercise of the powers contained in section 4 of the Prevention of Terrorism Act 2005, No. 12 of 2005 which authorises the Minister of Foreign Affairs to make such provision as may appear to him to be necessary or expedient to enable the measures of the United Nations Security Council 1267 Sanctions Committee to be effectively applied in Antigua and Barbuda.

#### 1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Security Council Resolution) (Amendment) (No. 17) Order, 2015.

#### 2. Commencement

The Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 10th day of July, 2015.

#### 3. Amendment of Schedule

The Schedule is being revised by amending the entity designated as —

<u>fundraising activities for Al-Qaida</u>, at least through 2012. He also collected money for the Taliban.
