THE PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 19) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in section 4 of the Prevention of Terrorism Act, 2005 No. 12 of 2005 which authorises the Minister of Foreign Affairs to make such provision as may appear to him to be necessary or expedient to enable the measures of the United Nations Security Council 1267 Sanctions Committee to be effectively applied in Antigua and Barbuda.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Security Council Resolution) (Amendment) (No. 19) Order, 2011.

2. Commencement

The Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 6^{th} day of September, 2011.

3. Amendment of Schedule

The Schedule is amended by revoking the entity designated as – QI.S.191.05, Name: 1: ABDUL LATIF 2: SALEH 3: na: 4: na, and adding the entity designated as – QI.M.296.11.Name: 1: MATI UR-REHMAN 2: na 3: na 4: na

On 19 August 2011, the Security Council Al-Qaida and Taliban Sanctions Committee decided to remove the name of Mr. Abdul Latif Saleh from its Consolidated List after concluding its consideration of the de-listing request submitted by this individual through the Ombudsperson established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1904 (2009), and after considering the Comprehensive Report of the Ombudsperson on this de-listing request.

Therefore, the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution1989 (2011) no longer apply to the following individual:
