THE PLANT PROTECTION (CONTROL OF QUARANTINE PEST) ORDER, made in exercise of the powers contained in section 4 of the Plant protection Act, Cap. 329.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Plant Protection (Control of Quarantine Pest) Order, 2011.

2. Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“*Achatina Fulica*” means the quarantine pest which is commonly known as the Giant African Land Snail;

“Conveyance” includes any item, including vehicles and containers, used or capable of being used for carrying materials;

“Goods” means any kind of moveable property;

“Plant material” means any goods that are wholly or partly derived from a member of the plant kingdom and includes soil;

“Quarantine pest” means a pest of potential economic importance to the area endangered thereby and not yet present there, or present but not widely distributed and being official controlled.

3. Movement of plant material, goods and conveyances

(1) A person shall not move any plant material, goods or conveyance suspected of carrying the quarantine pest *Achatina fulica* out of the controlled area.

(2) Any movement of plant material, goods or conveyance from the controlled area shall be authorized in writing by an officer of Plant Protection in the Department of Agriculture.
