THE PLANT PROTECTION (FEES) REGULATIONS made in exercise of the powers contained in section 48(2) (w) of the Plant Protection Act, 2012 No 18 of 2012.

#### 1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Plant Protection (Fees) Regulations, 2016.

#### 2. Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires –

"Minister" means the Minister with responsibility for Plant Protection.

#### 3. Establishment of Plant Protection Fee Schedule

- (1) The Minister makes the following Regulations which determine the scale of Fees that are to be charged under the Plant Protection Act, 2012 No.18 of 2012.
- (2) The provisions of the Schedule shall have effect as to the scale of Fees that are to be charged.
  - (3) The Minister may by Order published in the Gazette, vary the Schedule.
