Property Tax (Prescribed Forms) Order 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 12A, 13A, and 22A of the Property Tax Act Cap. 348 and section 57 of the Interpretation Act Cap. 224.

1. This Order may be cited as Property Tax (Prescribed Forms) Order 1996. Short title.

2. For the better carrying out of the provisions and purposes of the Property Tax Act Cap. 348 the following forms are prescribed for the purposes of capital valuation — Prescription of forms in Second Schedule.

Section 13 of the Property Tax Act 1986, provides *inter alia* that:

Any person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with this notice is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine, and any person who makes or causes to be made return which he knows to be false in any material particular is liable to a fine and to imprisonment.
