**THE POLICE WELFARE ASSOCIATION (AMENDMENT) RULES made in exercise of the powers contained in section 63 of the Police Act, Cap. 330.**

**1. Short title**

These Rules may be cited as the Police Welfare Association (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

**2. Interpretation**

In these Rules, “principal Rules” means the Police Welfare Association Rules 1949, S.R.O. No.14 of 1949.

**3. Amendment of Rule 3**

The principal Rules are amended in rule 3 by repealing sub rule (2) and substituting the following—

“(2) The members of the Board shall hold office for three years from the date of appointment and any such member shall be eligible for re-appointment, but shall not serve for more than six consecutive years.”.
