**A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 307 it shall be lawful for the Cabinet after the occurrence in Antigua and Barbuda of a hurricane, earthquake, fire or flood, to declare by proclamation in the *Gazette* that a state of emergency exists;

AND WHEREAS on the 4th day September, 1995 a hurricane known by the name of Luis occurred in Antigua and Barbuda;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Cabinet in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, (Cap. 307) hereby declares by this Proclamation that a state of emergency exists.
