This guideline is being issued by the Quarantine Authority by virtue of the powers contained in section 5 of the Quarantine Act, Cap. 361

1. Citation and commencement

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Quarantine (COVID-19) Guidelines (REPEAL) Order 2022.
- 2. This Order shall come into effect immediately upon publication in the *Gazette*.

2. Discontinuation of quarantine measures for incoming passengers

The measures contained in the Quarantine (Covid-19) Guidelines previously issued for incoming passengers, including visitors and returning nationals, transit and intransit passengers and which required vaccination, proof of vaccination, covid-19 testing, isolation and quarantine in specified circumstances are discontinued.

3. Repeal of Quarantine (COVID-19) Guidelines

The Quarantine (Covid-19) Guidelines 2021, published and contained in the Order cited as the Quarantine Guidelines for the Outbreak of COVID-19 in Antigua and Barbuda and published as Statutory Instrument No. 58 of 2021 and all subsequent amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
