Whereas by Section 3 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act Cap 148, it shall be lawful insofar as the proclamation declaring a state of emergency continues in force, for the Cabinet to make orders securing the essentials of life to the community and for the preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the public;

**AND WHEREAS** on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017, the Cabinet issued a Proclamation declaring a state of emergency and that Proclamation continues in force;

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with the Proclamation made on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017 the Cabinet made an Order, namely the Emergency Powers (Evacuation) Order, 2017, No. 62.

AND WHEREAS by Section 3 (3) of the Emergency Power Act, Cap. 148 any order so made shall be laid before the Legislature as soon as may be after it has been made, and shall not continue in force after the expiration of seven days from the time when it is so laid unless a resolution is passed by the Legislature providing for the continuance thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that this Honourable House approves the following Order—

(a) "The Emergency Powers (Evacuation) Order, 2017 (No. 62)"
