### **Representation of the People (Application for Registration) (Amendment) Regulations made under sections 2 and 9 of the Representation of the People Act.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People (Application for Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1998. Short title.

2. The qualifications for registration contained in Form A in the Schedule of the Representation of the People (Application for Registration) Regulations 1975 (No. 35 of 1975) made under sections 2 and 9 of the Representation of the People Act are hereby amended by: Form A amended.

- (i) adding the following qualification for registration to be referred to as *(c)* after qualification *(b)*, namely —

“(c) a citizen of Antigua and Barbuda on the date of his application for registration.”;

- (ii) deleting the word “either” in the line commencing with the words “A person of the age of eighteen years or over who is”;

- (iii) replacing the fullstop at the end of qualification for registration *(b)* with a semi-colon and adding immediately thereafter the word “or”;

- (iv) adding a new sub-clause *(c)* to number 6 of Form A as follows:

“(c) I was a citizen of Antigua and Barbuda on the date of my application for registration.”;

- (v) deleting the words "either (a) or (b)" from the last line of number 6 of Form A.

Commencement.

3. These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 1994.
