Resolution providing for the continuance of the State of Emergency declared by the Cabinet in accordance with Section 2 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act Cap. 148.

WHEREAS by section 2 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 148 it shall be lawful for the Cabinet after the occurrence in Antigua and Barbuda of a hurricane, earthquake, fire or flood, to declare by proclamation published in the *Gazette* that a state of emergency exists;

AND WHEREAS certain areas in Antigua were extensively damaged by hurricane Georges on the 21st day of September, 1998;

AND WHEREAS under section 2 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 148 the Cabinet by proclamation dated the 23rd day of September, 1998, declared a State of Emergency in Liberta, Crabb Hill, Five Islands, The area known as McPond in the Village of All Saints, and Bolans:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Honourable House that the Proclamation dated the 23rd day of September, 1998 be continued in force until the 22nd day of October, 1998.

Passed the House of Representatives this 28th day of September, 1998. Passed the Senate this 28th day of September, 1998.
