The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (100th Anniversary of First Manned Flight) Order 2003 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (100th Anniversary of First Manned Flight) Order 2003. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of \$2.00 on three (3) Sheetlets and three (3) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The Special Stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 27th October, 2003 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 28th July, 2003. Commencement.
