The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (100th Anniversary of the Nobel Prize) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 410 of the Laws of Antigua and Barbuda Revised Edition 1992.).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (100th Anniversary of the Nobel Prize) Order, 1995.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps are in two sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each and the denomination is \$1.00. There are also two (2) souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 9th February, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 8th November, 1995.
