# The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (150th Anniversary of the Greenbay Moravian Church) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (150th Anniversary of the Greenbay Moravian Church) Order, 1995.

**2. Special Stamp.** Special Stamps of the value of  $20\phi$ ,  $60\phi$ ,  $75\phi$ ,  $90\phi$ , \$1.20, \$2.00, and one Souvenir sheet at \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 25th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 4th day of September, 1995.
