

# ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1995, No. 29

**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (150th Anniversary of the Greenbay Moravian Church) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).**

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (150th Anniversary of the Greenbay Moravian Church) Order, 1995.

**2. Special Stamp.** Special Stamps of the value of 20¢, 60¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$2.00, and one Souvenir sheet at \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

**3. Design.** The design of the stamps authorized by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

**4. Duration.** The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 25th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.

**5. Commencement.** This Order comes into force on 4th day of September, 1995.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following —

60¢ depicts	— The first Stone/Concrete building dedicated in March, 1967.
75¢ depicts	— The Present Structure.
90¢ features	— The first Moravian Minister of African Descent — JOHN A. BUCKLEY.
\$1.20 features	— The longest serving Minister at Greenbay Moravian Church, Bishop JOHN EPHRAIM KNIGHT.
\$2.00 depicts	— The Present Structure.
