STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Scouts — 18th World Jamboree) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Scouts — 18th World Jamboree) Order, 1995.

2. Special Stamp. Special stamps depicting three types of permanent camp tent of the value of \$1.20 each and two (2) souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 29th October, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 5th October, 1995.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following —
