STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1993) (Mickey's Nutcracker) Order, 1993, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1993) (Mickey's Nutcracker) Order, 1993.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 10c., 15c., 20c., 30c., 40c., 50c., 60c., \$3.00, \$6.00 and two (2) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The Special Stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 7th February, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted which ever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 8th November, 1993.

SCHEDULE

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and feature the following —

Value	Description
10c.	features Marie and Fritz (Mickey's Nephew) with "the most beautiful tree in the World".
15c.	features Marie receiving the Nutcracker from Godfather Drosselmeir (Goofy).
20c.	features Fritz as he breaks Marie's Nutcracker.
30c.	features the Nutcracker (Mickey) leaping out of a cupboard.
40c.	features the Nutcracker Prince as he invites Marie home, "Let me take you to my kingdom, the land of sweets".

- 50c. features Marie and the Little Prince as they meet the Sugar Plum Fairy Clarabelle.
- 60c. features Marie and the Prince in Crystal Hall.
- \$3.00 features Cossack dancers Huey, Dewey and Louie
- \$6.00 features Mother Ginger (Grandma Duck) and her little puppets, the polichinelle (three little dancing ducklings).
- \$6.00 Souvenir Sheet I features Marie as "she threw her shoe as hard as she could "crying "Oh my poor Nutcracker".
- \$6.00 Souvenir Sheet II features Marie and Prince as they bid farewell to the Land of Sweets.
