The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda)_(Christmas 1994) Order, 1995, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1994) Order 1995.
- 2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 15ϕ , 35ϕ , 40ϕ , 45ϕ , 65ϕ , 75ϕ , \$1.20, \$5.00, and two Souvenir Sheets costing \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The design of the Stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- 4. Duration. The Special Stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three months until 13th March 1995, or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- **5.** Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 12th December, 1994.
