The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Trains) Order made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Trains) Order 1997. Short title.
2. Special Stamps of the value of \$1.65 on two sheetlets containing six (6) stamps each, and two (2) souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamps.
3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 9th February, 1998 or earlier if stock becomes exhausted before that date. Duration.
5. This Order comes into force on 10th November, 1997. Commencement.
