The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1999) Order, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Short title. Barbuda) (Christmas 1999) Order, 1999.
- 2. Special stamps of the value of 15¢, 25¢, 45¢, 60¢, \$2.00, \$pecial Stamp. \$4.00 and one (1) souvenir sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. The design of the Stamps authorised by this Order is Design. specified in the Schedule.
- 4. The Special Stamps authorised by this Order shall puration. remain on sale for the period of three (3) months until 21st February, 2000, or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 22nd Commencement. November, 1999.
