The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1999) Order, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 1999) Order, 1999. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 15¢, 25¢, 45¢, 60¢, \$2.00, \$4.00 and one (1) souvenir sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
3. The design of the Stamps authorised by this Order is specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The Special Stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for the period of three (3) months until 21st February, 2000, or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 22nd November, 1999. Commencement.

SCHEDULE

All the Stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following:—

Value		Description
15¢	<i>depicts</i>	Reuben – Madonna and Child in a wreath of flowers
25¢	<i>depicts</i>	Durer – Shroud of Christmas held by two Angels
45¢	<i>depicts</i>	Raphael – Madonna and Child enthroned between two saints
60¢	<i>depicts</i>	Raphael – Holy Family with the Lamb
\$2.00	<i>depicts</i>	Raphael – The Transfiguration

- \$4.00 depicts Durer – Three Putti holding a Coat of Arms
\$6.00 *Souvenir Sheet depicts* The Coronation of the Holy St. Catherine.
