**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Census 2001) Order
2001 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp
Act, Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Census 2001) Order 2001. Short title.
2. Special Stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
Schedule.
3. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall be released on sale at the General Post Office on 2nd April, 2001 and remain on sale until 1st July, 2001 or until stocks are exhausted whichever date is sooner. Duration.
4. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 2nd April, 2001. Commencement.

The Stamps are multicoloured and are of horizontal format and depict the following:

0.15¢	depicts	Bar graph of the population trend of Antigua and Barbuda Census from 1844 — 1991.
0.25¢	depicts	A population pyramid of Antigua and Barbuda 1991 by sex and age groups superimposed on a tourist map of Antigua and Barbuda with locations of Hotels and Guest Houses.
0.65¢	depicts	A pyramid bar chart of Censuses in Antigua and Barbuda 1844 — 1991.

<i>Value</i>		<i>Description</i>
0.90¢	depicts	A line graph of the population of Antigua and Barbuda superimposed on the tourist map of Antigua and Barbuda.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet depicts	The Census Logo, which is a Trade Mark of Census activities in Antigua and Barbuda.
