The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Christmas 2003) Order 2003 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Short title. Barbuda) (Christmas 2003) Order 2003.
- 2. Special Stamps of the value of 25¢, 30¢, 45¢, 50¢, 75¢, Special Stamps. 90¢, \$2.50 and one (1) Souvenir Sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are Design specified in the Schedule.
- 4. The Special Stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 9th February, 2004 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 10th Commencement. November, 2003.

50¢ depicts	Madonna and Child (Calci Parish Church) (Benozzo Gozzoli, 1421 — 1497).
75¢ depicts	Madonna and Child Giving Blessings (Benozzo Gozzoli, 1421 — 1497).
90¢ depicts	Madonna and Child (Master of the female half-figures, 1530 — 1540's).
\$2.50 depicts	The Benois Madonna (Leonardo Da Vinci, 1452 — 1519).
\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet depicts	The Virgin and Child with Angels (Rosso Horentino, 1495 — 1540).
