**The Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda) (21st Anniversary of Independence 1981 — 2002) Order 2002 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (21st Anniversary of Independence 1981—2002) Order 2002. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 25¢, 30¢, \$1.50, \$1.80 and two (2) Souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special stamps.
3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 30th January, 2003 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 31st October 2002. Commencement.

The stamps are multi-coloured, of vertical and horizontal format and depict the following —

25¢ depicts	The National Flag of Antigua and Barbuda
30¢ depicts	Antigua and Barbuda Coat of Arms
\$1.50 depicts	Mount St. John Hospital nearing completion
\$1.80 depicts	The Antigua and Barbuda Parliament Building

\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet 1 depicts	The Hon. Lester B. Bird, Prime Minister
