THE STAMP (ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA) (30TH ANNIVERSARY OF CHINESE LUNAR NEW YEAR 2010) ORDER, made in exercise of the powers contained in sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (30th Anniversary of Chinese Lunar New Year 2010) Order, 2010.

2. Special Stamps

Special Stamps which comprise Sheetlets of twelve (12) stamps at a value of 0.60¢ each, totalling \$7.20 per Sheetlet, depicting the 30th Anniversary of the Chinese Lunar New Year are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Duration

The Special Stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 13th May, 2010, or until stocks are exhausted, which ever is earlier.

4. Format

The Stamps are multi-coloured and are of vertical format.

5. Commencement

This Order comes into force on 14th February, 2010.
