The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (LIAT's 50th Anniversary 1956—2006) Order, 2007 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

Short Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (LIAT's 50th Anniversary 1956-2006) Order, 2007.

Special Stamps.

2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

Duration.

3. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 22nd January 2007, or until stocks are exhausted, which ever is earlier.

Commencement.

4. This Order comes into force on 23rd October, 2006.
