| 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (50th Anniversary of UNESCO) Order, 1997. | Short title. |
| 2. Special stamps of the value of 60¢, 90¢, \$1.00, \$1.20, \$1.50, \$1.75, and two (2) souvenir sheets at the value of \$6.00 each and two (2) sheetlets, sheetlet 1 of five (5) stamps at the cost of \$1.65 each and sheetlet 2 of eight (8) stamps at the cost of \$1.10 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. | Special Stamps. |
| 3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. | Design. |
| 4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 11th July, 1997 or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. | Duration. |
| 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 10th of April, 1997. | Commencement. |
