**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (90th Anniversary of Scouts Association) Order 2003 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda (90th Anniversary of Scout Association) Order 2003 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act Cap. 410. Short Title.

2. Special Stamps of the value of 30 cents, \$1.00, \$1.50, \$1.80 and one (1) sheetlet comprising three (3) stamps at 90 cents each and one Souvenir Sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamps.

3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.

4. The Special Stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 8th September, 2003 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.

5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 9th of June, 2003. Commencement.
