The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda Anniversaries and Events, 1994) Order, 1994, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Antigua and Barbuda Anniversaries and Events 1994) Order, 1994.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 35¢, 40¢, 50¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$1.50, \$2.00, \$3.00; one Sheetlet containing 8 stamps costing 75¢, each, two Sheetlets containing 6 stamps costing \$1.50 each and (5) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$3.00, \$4.00 and three at \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 5th November, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted which ever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 4th August, 1994.
