The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1995, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1995.
- 2. Special Stamps. Special stamps of the value of \$5.00 each; one sheetlet containing eight (8) stamps costing \$1.20 each, one sheetlet containing eight (8) stamps costing \$1.50 each, and two sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each and in the denominations of 75ϕ , 90ϕ , \$1.20; and five (5) souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this order are specified in the Schedule.
- 4. Duration. The Special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 28th September, 1995 or earlier if stocks become exhausted before that date.
 - 5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 20th July, 1995.
