

STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda—Marine Life) Order made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda—Marine Life) Order 1998.

2. Special Stamps of the value of 75¢, 90¢, \$1.00, \$1.20, \$1.50 \$1.75; two sheets containing six (6) stamps each at a cost of \$1.65 per stamp; and two (2) souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for three (3) months until 20th May, 1998 or earlier if stock becomes exhausted before that date.

5. This Order comes into force on 19th February, 1998.
