

ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1995, No. 30

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Ducks and Birds) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Ducks and Birds) Order, 1995.

2. Special Stamp. Special Stamps of the value of 75¢ each, featuring twelve different ducks and twelve different birds and two Souvenir sheets at \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 25th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 31st day of August, 1995.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and feature the following —

75¢	Sheetlet II features	— Ring-Necked, Ruddy Duck, Green-Winged Teal, Wood Duck, Hooded Merganser, Lesser Scalp, West Indian Tree Duck, Fulvous Whistling Duck, Bahama Duck, Shoveler, Masked Duck, American Widgeon.
