STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversary and Events) Order, 1993, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversary and Events) Order, 1993.
- **2. Special Stamps.** Special Stamps of the value of 10c., 15c., 30c., 40c., 60c., \$3.00, \$4.00, \$5.00; 6 Souvenir Sheets, one of the value of \$5.00 and 5 Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each, are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- **4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain in force until 15th November, 1993 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- **5.** Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 16th day of August, 1993.

SCHEDULE

1. 150th Anniversary of St. John's Lodge #492

The stamps in item 1 are multi-coloured, the 10c. and 60c. stamps are of vertical format and the 30c. and 40c. are of horizontal format and they feature the following—

Value	Description
10c.	depicts the Very Worshipful Brother W.K. Heath Grand Inspector, Leeward Islands 1961 — 1982.
30c.	features the Masonic Hall, St. John's, Antigua 1961 to present.
40c.	features the first Masonic Hall, St. John's, Antigua 1876 — 1960.
60c.	features the Very Worshipful Brother J.L.E. Jeffrey Grand Inspector, Leeward Islands 1953 - 1961.

2. Will Brandt — 1971 Nobel Peace Prize Recipient

The Stamps in item 2 are multi-coloured, of horizontal format and feature the following — $\,$

Value	Description
30c.	features Helmut Schmidt, George Leber and Will Brandt, 1975.
\$4.00	features Rally — "Brandt Must Stay Chancellor", 1972.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet features Willy Brandt, Chancellor of West Germany, 1969—1974 at Warsaw Ghetto Memorial, 1970.

3. 450th Anniversary in Memoriam of the astronomer Nicholas Corpernicus

The Stamps in item 3 are multi-coloured, of vertical format and feature the following —

Value	Description
40c.	features — A Contemporary instrument that Corpernicus was likely to use.
\$4.00	features — A Modern application of his scientific contribution. Corpernicus' special signature, the small "sum logo" is also featured on each stamp.
\$5.00	Souvenir Sheet features — A portrait of Corpernicus.

4. Prince Naruhito and Masako Owada June 9, 1993

The Stamps in item 4 are multi-coloured and of horizontal format and feature the following — $\,$

Value	Description
40c.	features — An inset of the Couple with Prince Naruhito on left.
\$3.00	features — An inset of the Couple with Masako Owada on right.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet features the Couple.

5. XXIV Winter Olympics 1994 — Norway

The Stamps in item 5 are multi-coloured and of horizontal format and feature the following — $\,$

Value	Description
15c.	features — The XI Winter Olympics — Pairs Figure Skating — Irina Rodnina and Alexei Oukanou, USSR.
\$5.00	features — XVI Winter Olympics — Giant Slalom, Alberto Tomba, Italy.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet features — Past Olympic medal winners of Women's 1500m speed skating:— Yvonne Van Gennip, Netherlands (gold), Karin Kania, East Germany (silver) and Andres Ehrigh, East Germany (bronze).

20th Anniversary of death of famous painter Pablo Picasso 1881 — 1973.

The Stamps in item 6 are multi-coloured and of horizontal format and feature the following — $\,$

Value	Description
30c.	portrays — A painting Cat and Bird, 1939.
40c.	portrays — A painting Fish on a Newspaper, 1957.
\$5.00	portrays — A painting Dying Bull, 1934.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet portrays — A painting Woman with a Dog, 1953.

7. William Jefferson Clinton — 42nd President of U.S.A.

The Stamps in this item are multi-coloured and of horizontal format and feature the following —

Value	Description
\$5.00	features — President William J. Clinton and inset in motorcade.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet features — Mr. Clinton taking the presidential oath with wife Hillary Clinton baside him and daughter on mounted horse.
