STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

1997, No. 14

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1997.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of \$1.75; two (2) stamps at \$1.65 and \$2.00; a sheetlet of three (3) stamps at the value of \$1.75 each; a sheetlet of six (6) stamps at \$1.00 each; a sheetlet of three (3) stamps at \$1.75 each; and four (4) souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 12th September, 1997 or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 12th June, 1997.

SCHEDULE

The Stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following —

\$1.75	depicts	Paul Percy Harris founder of Rotary International and James Grant, Rotary Volunteer.
\$1.65	depicts	Image of an innocent child and the logo of UNESCO.
\$2.00	depicts	Image of an innocent child and the logo of Chabad's Children of Chernobyl.

SHEETLETS

\$1.75	Sheetlet of three stamps	Each stamp depicting Von Stephan and Kaiser Wilhelm I of Universal Postal Union, Heinrich Von Stephan and the Greek god of speed Mercury, also the Pigeon Post.

<i>Value</i>	<i>Description</i>
\$1.00 Sheetlet of six stamps	Each stamp celebrating the Golden Wedding Anniversary of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness Prince Philip. The stamps depict photographs of the royal couple together and alone, the coat of arms of the Royal Family and the Royal Castles.
\$1.75 Sheetlet of three stamps	Each stamp celebrating the legacy of the Brothers Grimm Fairy Tales and depicting Cinderella's wicked stepmother and stepsisters, Cinderella, and the fairy godmother; also Cinderella dancing with the charming Prince.

\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet (1) depicts	Rotary Volunteers in New Zealand.
\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet (2) depicts	Heinrich Von Stephan, founder of the Universal Postal Union.
\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet (3) depicts	The Royal Couple walking down the steps of Buckingham Palace.
\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet (4) depicts	The Prince trying the magical slippers on the feet of Cinderella.
