The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1998 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1998. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special stamps.
3. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 17th February, 1999 or until stocks are exhausted whichever date is sooner. Duration.
4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th November, 1998. Commencement.
