1999, No. 31

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 1999. Short title.

2. Special Stamps of the value of \$1.00, \$1.20, \$1.65, \$1.90; Sheetlets with stamp valuing \$1.65, \$1.75 and \$3.00 each and seven (7) souvenir sheets at the value of \$6.00 for each stamp. Special Stamps.

3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.

4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 23rd September, 1999 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration

5. This Order is deemed to have come into effect on 24th June, 1999. Commencement.
